About:

The Parish of St Augustine, All Saints, within the Diocese of Salford, is recruiting a Cleaner (x2) to maintain a clean, tidy, hygienic, and efficiently run parish house, maintaining the highest standards of cleanliness. As part of the designated areas, the successful candidate will be required to clean the church which is a Grade II listed building.

What we are looking for:

The successful candidate will carry out a variety of general and deep cleaning duties including but not limited to sweeping, mopping, vacuuming, laundry, dusting and in areas including bathrooms and kitchens. The location is a large site with different aspects including halls.

What you will need:

The Cleaner will have experience of cleaning and housekeeping duties and be able to work on their own initiative as well as under the direction of the Parish Priest. They will be aware of safeguarding, health and safety requirements and be able to apply these considerations to their everyday work.
